MSH POST EVALUATION RFQ AWARD REPORT FORENSIC PSYCHOLOGIST SERVICES: RFQ 12.28.2022.003 February 27, 2023

In compliance with section 3-204.04 of the Mississippi Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations, we hereby offer the following summary. In response to the RFQ listed above, MSH received three (3) statement of qualifications. Statement of qualifications were submitted by Ashley Batastini Ph.D., Gina Mire Ph.D., and David Gavel Ph.D., in evaluation order ranking from highest to lowest. The MSH Forensic Psychologist Services RFQ Evaluation Committee, after thorough blind review, made the following summary determinations: (1) The statement of qualifications from all three Offerors meet all RFQ requirements, offered sufficient education and certification levels, offered sufficient past performance history, and offered sufficient licensure/regulatory compliance to meet contractual requirements. All three Offerors agreed to accept the mandatory salary, set by MSH, to perform the required services. (2) All three Offeror's Statement of Qualifications meet all RFQ requirements and provided adequate details in specified service areas.

The eventual contract for these services shall include all terms, conditions, and scope of services specified in the original RFQ document issued by MSH. The contract shall also include the terms and conditions of the MSH standard independent contractor agreement. Based on the above information, the MSH Forensic Psychological Services Committee has determined and makes the recommendation that a contract should be awarded to all three Offerors. The MSH Forensic Psychologist Evaluation Committee proposes that based on pre-determined rating criteria, all three Offerors have submitted acceptable Statement of Qualifications.

RE: AWARD ANALYSIS

These contracts for our request for qualifications number 12.28.2022.003 (RFX - 3140003341), to provide professional Forensic Psychologist Services, are being recommended for award as a multiple provider award to all three of the respondents submitting statement of qualifications (SOQ) as stated in the original RFQ. All SOQs received were evaluated thoroughly for responsiveness of the SOQ and responsibility of the provider. As allowed by OPSCR rules and regulations, contract award is being recommended to multiple providers. Determination was made, by MSH staff, that the SOQs recommended for acceptance are competitive based on historical market pricing for the required services. The successful offerors also have a verified proven ability to perform required services based on historical references from other customers and MSH staff.

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
