RE: AWARD ANALYSIS

These contracts for our bid number 07.13.2021.473 (RFX - 3160004328), to provide professional interpreter services, are being recommended for award as a multiple vendor award to both bidders that submitted bids. All bids received were evaluated thoroughly for responsiveness of the bid and responsibility of the vendors. As allowed by OPSCR rules and regulations, bid award is being recommended to multiple vendors. Determination was made that the bids recommended for acceptance are competitive based on historical market pricing for the required services. The successful bidders also have a proven ability to perform required services based on historical references from other customers and MSH staff.
